Our 32nd season of planting trees + growing community was like no other. In addition to continuing challenges brought on by COVID 19, the Pacific Northwest experienced a "one-in-a-1,000-year" heat event. We mourn the loss of life that resulted from this unprecedented event. While we acknowledge that trees are not the only solution, trees' ability to provide shade and reduce the heat island effect are part of the solution.

We know that trees fight climate change. At Friends of Trees, we've learned from partnering with thousands of community members that the volunteer experience itself also helps fight climate change: folks who volunteer to plant and care for trees often go on to become involved with other environmental issues, including taking climate action.

From volunteer tree planters to municipal and business partners, foundation funders and individual donors, everyone can play a role in one of the simplest solutions to a warming planet: Planting trees. Together.

In 2021, 930 volunteers came together to plant 21,311 trees and native shrubs, donating 10,400 hours. That's 870,000+ trees and native shrubs since 1989!




